



Dianthus Care

- Part to full sun
- Dianthus won't tolerate overly wet soil and needs a well draining location
- Deadheading the plants after their first bloom can help ensure a second bloom later in summer or early in the fall
- They won't need much in the way of traditional fertilizer.
 - A shovelful of compost worked into the soil once a year is enough to nourish the plants
